

TOWN OF BLUFF RESOLUTION NO. 2021- 55

**A RESOLUTION CANCELLING THE FALL 2021 TOWN GENERAL ELECTION DUE TO THE FACT THAT ALL POSITIONS UP FOR ELECTION ARE UNOPPOSED**

The following describes the intent and purpose of this resolution:

- a. The Town of Bluff general election is scheduled for November 2, 2021. Two Town Council seats are up for election, as is the Mayor.
- b. As of October 8, 2021 it was determined that all candidates for the above positions are running unopposed. No persons have submitted candidate declarations to become a write-in candidate as of the statutory deadline. Therefore, the number of municipal officer candidates does not exceed the number of open municipal offices.
- c. All Town elected offices are at-large positions.
- d. There are no Town ballot propositions on the election ballot.
- e. State law authorizes the cancellation of local elections not less than 20 days prior to the scheduled election, provided that certain statutory requirements are met, and all at-large offices are unopposed. U.C.A. § 20A-1-206.

THEREFORE, the Bluff Town Council enacts as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are found to be correct and are incorporated into this resolution. The Town finds that all statutory prerequisites have been satisfied. The Town general election of November 2, 2021 is hereby cancelled pursuant to the authority referenced above. The Town Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to provide notice of the cancellation of the municipal election by posting same on the statewide voter information website, posting on the Town website, publishing (twice) in a local newspaper of general circulation, and posting same on the Utah Public Notice website, as otherwise provided by law.

Approved and enacted by the vote of a majority of the Bluff Town Council at a properly noticed meeting of the Council in which quorum was present this 11<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2021.
