Discuss and Approve Amendments and Adopted 2021 Budget

Leppanen explained the Council held the Tentative Budget Hearing on June 16th but there have been several changes since then so we need to make amendments.

The adjusted certified tax rate changed from \$24,000 to \$30,173. This has been approved by the State.

The Town received funds from the Covid Relief Fund in the amount of \$7,164.

Leppanen and Mack McDonald worked together to get Bluff on the State list. There may be two more disbursements. This revenue can only be spent on specific Covid related things and Leppanen suggested a work session to go over possibilities and compliance.

The third change is the listing of the CDBG grant as \$91,000. The CDBG has it as \$91,500. Leppanen will check to see which amount is correct.

There were no comments from the audience.

Sayers motioned to approve the 2021 budget as amended, Hook seconded and Leppanen, Hook, Sayers, and Sosa voted in favor.

Sayers motioned to adjourn at 9:17 a.m., Hook seconded and Leppanen, Hook, Sayers, and Sosa voted in favor.
